RQ845 RQ893	<p>This Requirements covers two major improvements to AMS</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Stage 1 of a major user Interface Improvements (<i>Additional changes will follow in future releases.</i>) 2) Introduction of workflow concepts to Project Brief. <p>Following extensive user research undertaken in 2012 and 2013 Kallik committed to a major overhaul to the AMS user interface. The first parts of the system to be addressed have been a) Project Brief (also now known as the Manuscript Process) and the Approval screens (see RQ973)</p> <p>As part of this work we have also introduced significant new functionality into the Project Brief. Introduction of Manuscript review functionality - this allows users to review and comment on content selected during the Project Brief stage with new functions including but not limited to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Automated 'data preview' generation (in addition to on-demand) 2. Document approval initiation for 'data preview' files 3. Document approval via Workflow Manager (including 'what's changed' report integration for subsequent versions) 4. Document comment collation via Brief Manager (enabling users to update project brief based on document approval comments) 5. Document upload and view improvements 6. Significantly improved "stale data" concept ensuring all "not current" data is easily identified by the user. <p>What this new functionality provides allows the Project Brief to be reviewed by the contributors or a different group of users. This review process has annotation tools and review tools similar to those used in the Artwork approval process.</p> <p>Note: Kallik will be providing Webinar based training for your users.</p>
RQ973	<p>Stage 1 (<i>Additional changes will follow in future releases.</i>)</p> <p>User Interface Improvements - update to the Approval Screens to bring in line with new AMS style.</p>
RQ84	<p>Forgotten password feature added to the AMS Login page which allows the user to reset their password.</p>
RQ1053	<p>With the new and improved inbox we have implemented a 'search as you type' feature which will help you find the task you're looking for much faster.</p>
RQ1144	<p>A 'news banner' has also been added to the AMS 5.2 Login page to provide an additional</p>

IN3483, <i>Client Ref 5420</i>	The bug has been fixed where; when creating a results folder to start a project with multiple components, when a user clicks on the results folder the pop window appears and lets the user enter a name for the folder. However when the user pressed close or ok nothing happened and in some case (browser dependent) it was not possible to close the box.
