RQ1290	<p>The Object Manager is a new Module added to the AMS Product Family. This new Module enables users to create Structured Objects and build and maintain relationships between Phrases/Claims (stored in the Phrase Manager), and Assets (specifically Documents stored in the Asset Manager).</p> <p>For example, a user may create a new Object to represent a product launching in Summer 2018.</p> <p>The product uses several Marketing Phrases/Claims from the Phrase Manager, and each of the Phrases/Claims has a number of PDF Documents which justify, or substantiate this Phrase/Claim.</p> <p>The Structured Object created in the Object Manager would be represented as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Product launched in 2018<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Phrase/Claim A used in product labelling<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Documentation to justify, or substantiate this Phrase/Claim● Phrase/Claim B used in product labelling<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Documentation to justify, or substantiate this Phrase/Claim● Structured Object Notes <p>The new Module provided the functionality to generate and store a Structured Object report in the Asset Manager for future reference.</p> <p>Access to the new module is controlled by user access roles, and Module licenses.</p> <p>Please speak to your Client Success Manager for more information.</p>

RQ2428	BI - The underlying software supporting the BI module has been upgraded from v5.2 to v6.4.2. The majority of changes relate to the security methods and internal functionality of the software, however users will see some minor changes such as the placement of control icons and display of some report parameters and selection items. Supporting material available.

IN:7021 nService#: 10902	BM - An issue was detected whereby the HTML Brief in the Brief Manager was displaying HTML coding character. This has been resolved and the HTML Brief will no longer render these HTML characters. Supporting material available.
IN:7025 nService#: 10867	SI - An issue was detected in the XML FTP transfer process that could allow the first instance of the component ID to be used rather than the latest ID. The method has now been updated to ensure the latest ID and therefore version, is included in the transfer.
IN:6903 nService#: 9976 / 10290 / 10802	DAM - The Name, Description and Keywords in the Asset Manager were being shared across Master and Variations. This has been improved so that Name, Description, and Keywords are now independent across Master and Variations. This affects both the Asset Manager and Phrase Manager* when users are editing the name, description and keywords via the asset metadata dialog. Although this only specifically affects clients that use the Master/Variant function it has necessitated a change to the underlying database schema. In addition, a number of BI reports have been updated to reflect this database schema change. Supporting material available. *This only affects the Phrase Manager database structure and not PM functionality.
