New Factory Printing Desktop Solution

A new Factory Printing technology for label printing has been created to allow for the local printing of pre-generated labels using a desktop web application that utilizes a local print engine. This will be made available to clients to evaluate in a phased approach. A number of server side API's have been introduced to facilitate Factory Print Desktop but in order to remove all risk from the existing Factory Printing solution, this new technology has been developed in a ring-fenced environment, and as such, no changes to the technology used by the existing Factory Printing solution have been made. See outline requirements below for the features that will be coming in 6.5 Patch 1.

AAG Realignment

With the 6.5 release we are updating all client AAG servers to the latest available build. This build has some minor bug fixes and performance improvements.

Annotations Tool

Following the implementation of the latest version of Annotations Tool, we have fed back comments made by our customers to the developers of the tool, and they have agreed to reimplement the UI feature whereby comments on document are connected to the list via a line. This has been added to their roadmap and we will provide updates to you when we receive them.
